DRONES ON CENTRE EVENTS



PLEASE NOTE DRONES ARE NOT PERMITTED TO BE FLOWN ON A RALLY/EVENT WITHOUT PRIOR PERMISSION FROM CLUB VIA COMMITTEE.

A drone operator must provide evidence of insurance and a certificate that they have registered the drone with the CAA see

www.dronesafe.co.ukformoreinformation.

The Centre also needs to ensure that the attendees have provided permission and are aware of the drone being flown under GDPR.



Important Notice

In the interest of safety please place a Fire Bucket (Red if possible) full of water outside your caravan on Rallies.

In the event of a fire these buckets would be our 1st line of defence, are easy to pick up and may help save someone's caravan.



Fire Extinguishers

Caravanners are advised to carry a Fire Extinguisher, ideally this should be a dry powder (for LPG) and/or an Aqueous Film-Forming Foam (AFF).

Remember



Dog owners always keep your dog on a lead (no more than 6ft) while on the Rally Field.

Exercise them away from sited vans.
